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COLLECTION DESCRIPTION

This collection is the result of research collected for the 2012 THC exhibit on the 1918 influenza epidemic in Tompkins County. The collection is comprised of *Ithaca Journal* news articles from September through December of 1918 concerning the flu epidemic; *Ithaca Journal* obituary and death notices from December 1914 through December 1919; research conducted on individual victims; miscellaneous publications mentioning influenza, including Ithaca public health reports and various histories of the city; The Cornell University Register 1917-18; various issues of the Cornell Alumni News and *The Daily Sun*; and newspaper excerpts concerning the Red Cross in 1918.
