#### COLLECTION DESCRIPTION

The collection consists of family albums, memoirs, letters and other miscellaneous items belonging to the Fincher family of Ithaca. They are dated from 1903-2013.

Myron G. Fincher was born on Nov 25, 1898 in Corfu, NY. He graduated from Cornell University as a Doctor of Veterinary Medicine in June 1920. He married Evelyn Davis on June 28, 1924 in Haddonfield, NY. They had three daughters, Joyce Edna Fincher, Ester Margaret Fincher and Myra Jean Fincher. Myron Fincher taught large Animal Medicine and Obstetrics at Cornell from 1920-65. He received the Borden Award in 1954 for his contribution to the study of diseases of dairy cattle.

The collection has two photo albums of Joyce Fincher with her family dated from 1937-47. A scrapbook belonging to Myra Fincher dates from 1952-59. The miscellaneous items include memoirs, newspaper clippings, certificates and family photographs.
