COLLECTION DESCRIPTION

This collection gathers materials relating to urban planning and development in the City of Ithaca. Its contents range from an early report on the recommendations of the New York State Department of Public Works for the downtown area, to a collection of maps showing various trends in the Ithaca area, to plans for a residential development on Elm Street and Maple Avenue. These materials inform our understanding of the Ithaca we see today and its development throughout the 20th century. This collection offers a detailed view of the motives, processes, and results of urban development in Ithaca and the various organizations that undertook these projects.
