COLLECTION DESCRIPTION

This collection contains material related to the history of the Cayuga Rock Salt Company, established in 1919 in Lansing, NY and bought by Cargill, Inc. in 1969. The mine has historically produced salt for chemical and industrial use, as well as road salt, but under Cargill's ownership solely produces road salt used throughout the northeast as a de-icer.

Material includes correspondence, a detailed descriptions of mining, ephemera, newspaper clippings and a 1971 mine survey.
